

A MESSAGE TO THE CITIZENS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

On Election Day Franklin County residents serve the voters in our county by working as Poll Workers. Now you can be included in that number. As a Poll Worker at one of our polling places, you would play an active role in ensuring the on-going success of the electoral process.

We need dedicated individuals who take pride in their work, are patient and enjoy working with people, and who take direction well and are detail oriented.

Whenever possible, Poll Workers are assigned to their "home" precinct. However, if there are no vacancies at your polling place, you may be asked to work at a nearby precinct. You are required by the state to attend trainings for every Primary and General Election that you work as a Poll Worker. These trainings are held at the Elections and Registration Office in Carnesville, GA. On Election Day you must report to your assigned polling place by 6:00 a.m. and remain until all voters have left and closing procedures are completed. Poll Officials pay ranges from \$110.00 to \$150.00 for the day.

The Franklin County Board of Registrations and Elections and your fellow Franklin County citizens appreciate those who help us make our elections work.
