**OFFICIAL PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY
BALLOT OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY
OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA
MARCH 1, 2016**

To vote, blacken the Oval (●) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, manually WRITE his or her name in the write-in section and blacken the Oval (●) next to the write-in section. If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only blue or black pen or pencil.

Do not vote for more candidates than the number allowed for each specific office. Do not cross out or erase. If you erase or make other marks on the ballot or tear the ballot, your vote may not count.

If you change your mind or make a mistake, you may return the ballot by writing "Spoiled" across the face of the ballot and return envelope. You may then mail the spoiled ballot back to your county board of registrars, and you will be issued another official absentee ballot. Alternatively, you may surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.

"I understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law." [OCGA 21-2-284(e) and 21-2-383(a)]

SPECIAL ELECTION

**Continuation of 1% Sales Tax for Educational
Purposes**
(Vote for One)

Shall a special one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes be continued in Franklin County for a period not to exceed twenty (20) calendar quarters beginning upon expiration of the sales and use tax for educational purposes presently in effect, and for the purpose of raising not more than \$20,000,000 of net proceeds by said tax, which shall go to the School District for the purpose of (i) constructing, renovating, and equipping a Career Technical and Agricultural Education ("CTAE") career academy on the Franklin County High School campus and constructing and equipping additions to Carnesville Elementary School Intermediate campus; (ii) adding to, renovating, repairing, improving, acquiring and equipping school buildings and school system facilities; (iii) acquiring miscellaneous new equipment, fixtures and furnishings for the school system, including computer technology equipment, computer software, school buses and other vehicles, transportation and maintenance equipment, and security and safety equipment; (iv) acquiring land or improving land for new or existing schools; (v) acquiring textbooks, e-books, and e-book readers for the school system, with the maximum cost of the projects described in items (i)-(v) payable from said tax being \$20,000,000; (vi) paying any general obligation debt of the School District issued in conjunction with the imposition of such sales and use tax; and (vii) paying the expenses incident to accomplish the foregoing.

If the imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of Franklin County School District in the principal amount of \$13,395,000 for the purposes of the Franklin County School District described in items (i)-(v) above and for the purpose of payment of a portion of the interest on such debt.
